

# REFUND POLICY

UWA NETBALL CLUB

By registering with the UWA Netball Club you are committing to playing and supporting the club (coaching, umpiring etc.) for the entire season. We strongly advise that you read our website including the code of conduct, training and game information.

Registering to play denotes an ongoing commitment for the season and is relied upon by the club to carry out significant pre-season administration and selection processes. Player withdrawals after registration cause considerable rework for the Grading Committee and are disruptive to the selection process.

### **Voluntary Withdrawal**

Prior to Selection Trials

A player can de-register and receive a full refund of their registration fee less a \$50 administration fee.

Commencement of Selection Trials

A player can de-register and receive a 50% refund less a \$50 administration fee.

Completion of Selection Trials

No refund will be given once selection trials are complete and teams announced unless due to extenuating circumstances (Injury or Illness Withdrawal see below).

The following reasons are not extenuating circumstances and therefore refunds will not be given:

- Dislike of the team into which the player has been selected
- Dislike of the allocated coach
- Unavailability to train at the allocated time/day
- Preferences not being met eg not playing with friends
- Dislike of the grade in which the team is playing in
- Other sport/social commitments/school elective activities
- Change of mind by players/parents

### **Injury or Illness Withdrawal (medical certificate must be provided)**

Prior to Selection Trials

A player can de-register and receive a full refund of their registration fee.

Commencement of Selection Trials

A player can de-register and receive a full refund less a \$50 administration fee.

Completion of Selection Trials

A player can de-register and receive a 75% refund less the PNA and Netball WA fees and a \$50 administration fee.

After Round Three has been played

No refund will be given.
